

DISPENSATION FOR MEMBERS AND CO-OPTED MEMBERS OF MID DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL 2012 TO 2015

In accordance with Part 3 of the District Council's Constitution (Responsibility for Functions - Scheme of Delegation) I hereby declare that, for the period of 21st November 2012 to 7th May 2015, all Members and Co-opted Members of the District Council shall not be regarded as having a disclosable pecuniary interest as defined in the Council's Code of Conduct and have been granted a dispensation to permit them to speak and vote at meetings of the District Council, its Cabinet or any Committee, Sub-Committee, Joint Committee or Working Party thereof if the matter relates to any of the following functions of the District Council, namely:

- Housing: if you hold a tenancy or lease with the authority, as long as the matter does not relate to your particular tenancy or lease
- Any allowance, travelling expenses, payment or indemnity for Members or Co-opted Members of the Council
- If you are receiving or eligible to receive statutory sick pay, under Part X1 of the Social Security and Benefits Act 1992, as amended
- Any ceremonial honour to be given to Members
- The setting of the Council Tax or precept
